

ARTICLE III

Officers, Directors, Governing Board

Section 3. The President, in each election year (i.e. 1972 and each even-numbered year thereafter), shall issue a call for nominations of Officers and Directors, which shall be published in the appropriate issue of The Mich-Matist or in a newsletter, which issue or newsletter shall be mailed to all members of the Society by April 1 of the said election year. All nominations shall be made in writing to the Secretary-Treasurer, during the period from April 1 through May 1 of said election year. Nominations may be made by all members, other than Junior Members. No member may nominate himself, or herself, or nominate for office a number of candidates in excess of that to be elected for said office. The Secretary-Treasurer shall promptly write to each member receiving at least two nominations for a given office, notifying him or her of such nomination and requesting his or her written acceptance or refusal thereof. Such nominee shall mail or deliver such written acceptance or refusal to the Secretary-Treasurer not later than May 31 of said election year or, upon failing to do so, shall be deemed to have declined such nomination. No nominee may accept a nomination for more than one elective office in any one election.

Call for Nominations of Officers and Directors by Brett Irick, President, MSNS R9071

An election for Officers and Directors will be held this year for a term of two years. The MSNS Constitution Article III Section 3 requires that the MSNS President make a call for nominations for the positions of President, Vice President and twelve Directors. Nominations can be made by all except Junior MSNS members. Nominees must be MSNS members in good standing for at least one (1) year, attained the age of eighteen (18) and be a resident of the State of Michigan. The nomination period will be open from April 1 to May 1. No member can nominate him or herself, or nominate for office a number of candidates in excess of that to be elected for said office. Nominations, in writing by either e-mail or hard copy letter are to be sent to MSNS Secretary Andrew Blinkiewicz at ablinky@gmail.com or to MSNS Attention: Secretary Andrew Blinkiewicz Box 301 Algonac, MI 48001. The Secretary will promptly write to each member receiving at least two nominations for a given office, notifying him or her of such nomination and requesting his or her written acceptance or refusal of the nomination. A written acceptance or refusal must be received no later than May 31. If no acceptance or refusal is received by May 31, a nomination defaults to refused.
